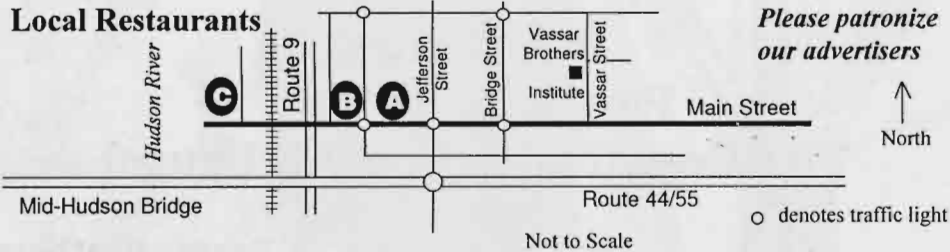

ABOUT THE BANDS:

We are pleased to present four bands today. **Fox Hill**, our feature band joining us for the first time today, is a five piece band from New Jersey that plays traditional and contemporary bluegrass. Fox Hill is known for its versatility and its distinctive sound. The group features three different lead singers and a variety of vocal arrangements, sometimes using four part harmony in secular and gospel songs. They offer fast moving, dynamic, high energy bluegrass at its best. **Fox Hill** has performed at concerts and festivals throughout the northeast, including the famous "Old Schoolhouse" at Lucketts, Virginia.

The band consists of **Earl Karlsen** (mandolin, vocals), **Ed Krizni** (guitar, vocals), **Roger Legendre** (bass, vocals), **Terry McGill** (banjo, vocals), and **Don Sojka** (dobro, vocals).

Joining **Fox Hill** are three familiar bands -- **Breakeven**, **Pancake Hollow** and **The Boys from Shelton Laurel**. **Breakeven** has been a long time favorite of HVBA members. The group includes **Joan Harrison** (banjo), **James Calberson** (fiddle) and **Betsy Paris** (guitar).

Pancake Hollow's rotating personnel includes **Jeffrey Anzevino** (vocals, dobro, harmonica), **Rich Hinds** (vocals, guitar), **Frank Kara** (vocals, mandolin) and **Ambrose Verdibello** (vocals, fiddle).

The Boys from Shelton Laurel feature two radio personalities from WHVW (am 95): **L.C. Smith** (banjo) and **Cueman** (guitar). **Frank Kara** on mandolin, **Terry Ghee** on fiddle and **Jim Romine** on bass round out the bluegrass quintet.

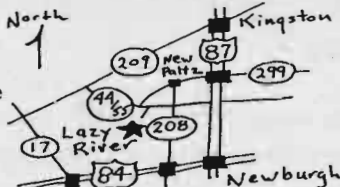
